

It has not been possible to determine the extent of duplicated efforts from the crude data. Most libraries have been using other libraries' analytics when they are available. There is no doubt however that some degree of duplication does exist. There are 12 series that have been analyzed by author and title by at least 7 libraries. The 近代中國史料叢刊 has been fully analyzed (author, title and subject) by 13 libraries. It is imperative that we have better coordination to make available what has been done and to share the work to create greater accessibility through more analytics.

--This survey was sent to me for my own edification. According to its author, the report was compiled in 1971, but has never been published. Although, as he stated in his letter, he did not have the time to follow up and double check a number of "suspicious" items, it is certainly worthy of publication. This is particularly relevant at a time when we are discussing how to promote inter-library cooperation and avoid duplicating efforts. I am grateful to Mr. Wan for permitting me to make this useful statistical analysis known to our colleagues.

Since one report was not eligible for consideration because the library questioned had no East Asian collection, the above survey was compiled from the remaining 43 reports.
