INSTITUTIONAL NEWS AND PROJECTSCHICAGO INSTITUTE FOR FAR EASTERN LIBRARIANSHIP ADMITS THIRTY

Since the announcement of the Institute for Far Eastern Librarianship to be held at the University of Chicago on June 23 - August 1, some 150 inquiries and 70 applications have been received. A total of 30 participants have been selected and admitted with a stipend of \$450 each plus \$90 per dependent for the six-week period. A number of them are library employees requiring new orientation recommended by their respective institutions and others are students in library science or in East Asian studies to be trained for employment. Requests have been received for recommendations of institute participants after training to new positions or for reporting their performance at the Institute as a basis for possible promotion.
